Memory Verse

Main Idea: Believe me when I say I am in the Father. Also believe that the Father is in me. Or at least believe what the miracles show about me. John 14:11

Objectives: Children will learn that Jesus performed many miracles. Some showed his control over nature and with others, He healed people. He performed these miracles to reinforce to people that He was who He said He was, the Son of God. Jesus' healings and miracles provided people with an experience of Gospel and the opportunity to become new people; to glorify God-in-Jesus and to share Good News. Jesus' miracles were proof that he was the Messiah.

There are 37 of Jesus' miracles recorded in the gospels. There are 21 of Jesus' miracles recorded in Matthew, three of which only appear in Matthew. There are 19 of Jesus' miracles recorded in Mark, two of which only appear in Mark. There are 22 of Jesus' miracles recorded in Luke, seven of which only appear in Luke. And there are 8 of Jesus' miracles recorded in John, six of which only appear in John. During this rotation, students will learn that there are four primary types of miracles that Jesus performed and will focus on one example of each type in each workshop.

Art: Miracles over Nature: Calming the Storm

Cooking: Miracles over Demons: The Gerasene Demoniac (casting out demons)

Games: Miracles of Supply: The Wedding at Cana (water into wine)

Music: Miracles of Healing: Raising Jairus' Daughter

Video: A variety of miracles will be shown in the video
